Core/Flex Model

- **CORE or FAST** (Focused Academic Support Time)

Fast/Core is for all students with grades below a C. Students & parents can self-refer.

- Report to assigned advisor on time every day. (Regular tardy/attendance policy applies.)
- Bring all needed materials to class.
- Work to complete assignments and improve grades and skills.
- Use Skyward to track assignments and know what is due/missing.
- Receive individual/small group tutoring from teachers and peers.
- Learn organizational/study strategies through AVID.
- If a student needs to report to another teacher, it must be pre-arranged using a FAST pass. Requests to leave **will not** be honored if student does not have a pass.

- **FLEX** (Student reward time for taking responsibility for grades.)

Flex is for all students who have earned a C or above in all classes.

- Report to advisor for attendance and then select a location to work. If students leave the classroom, they need to sign out.
- Students may be in the following locations -
 - Gym to shoot hoops or exercise
 - Library for quiet study hall
 - Lunchroom for group projects and/or visiting
 - A classroom for extra help, studying or tutoring
- All regular school rules apply and campus is closed.
- Use time according to personal needs.
- Attend to advisory/club/leadership business or volunteer.
- Serve as a peer mentor/tutor - See Ms. Petterson to sign up.
