Pictures

Pictures will be on Wednesday, September 10th beginning at 1:00. In addition to pictures, Bell Studios will also create ID or ASB cards for our students at no cost. Students can purchase an ASB card for \$40.00 in the high school office. The ASB card is required to play sports and allows students to attend events free and/or at a discounted rate. If students cannot make this date, we will have retakes on October 15th beginning at 1:00.

Athletics

The first day of football is Wednesday, August 20 and volleyball, cross country and cheer begin on Monday, August 25th. Students and parents need to sign all electronic forms in Final Forms and have a current physical on file in order to be eligible for the first day of practice. Student athletes are required to purchase a 25-26 ASB card and pay a participation fee to be eligible for the first competition. ASB Cards are \$40.00 (Cash or Checks made payable to WHS) and Pay to Participate is \$60.00 (Cash or Checks made payable to WSD). Schedules

You will find student schedules on Skyward. To help the first few days of school go smoothly, all schedule changes should be made **before** school begins. Advisory & Mule Success

Our high school students start each day with Mule Success. This allows students time to prepare for the day and gain a better understanding of graduation requirements, senior portfolios/projects and post high school options. This class is called College/Career Ready and it is worth .5 credits each year and recorded on student transcripts. It is important for students to do this work to ensure they have a solid post-secondary high school plan.

Attendance

Developing good attendance habits is a key part of student success in high school and life. If your student is going to be absent, please call the office after 8:00 or email Haannah hohrberg@wahksd.k12.wa.us. We need to know your student's name and why they are going to be absent. Students are marked unexcused if the office isn't notified or if the reason isn't approved. Lockers

If requested, students are issued a hall locker, and if they have a physical fitness class or play a sport they will also be issued a PE locker. Students are encouraged to keep both lockers locked at all times. <u>Please remind your student that the school is not responsible for lost or stolen items that are not kept in locked lockers</u>. It only takes a second – lock up your valuables!

School Supplies

Organization is key to success in both high school and college. These skills are learned and require practice. We will provide all students with a planner on the first day of school. Please make sure your student comes to school on the first day with a three ring binder, dividers, notebook paper, a pencil pouch, pencils, pens, highlighters, colored pencils, a glue stick, and scissors. If taking a PE class, students are required to have PE shoes, shorts and a t-shirt. Starting the school year prepared pays off!
