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Wahkiakum High School's online program is offered through OSPI's approved online providers. These companies provide students the opportunity to take classes outside the traditional classroom. A variety of courses are offered online and available to WHS students. Students interested in participating in the program may apply to enroll in one or more online classes. Although online students are not participating in a traditional classroom, they will be expected to complete their work each day on a computer in the school library. Continued enrollment in WHS's online program is determined by successful academic progress. Priority is given to juniors and seniors with scheduling conflicts or academic needs that cannot be met by our regular schedule. Not all classes are NCAA approved; WHS recommends that students interested in playing college sports stay in the traditional classroom.

Application Process

- 1. Student completes the application packet. Packets are available at the high school office or on our school website.
- 2. All applications are due prior to the start of a new semester.

August 25th – First Semester Deadline January 19th – Second Semester Deadline

3. Only completed applications will be reviewed for acceptance. If accepted, students will need to meet with the principal to complete registration.

Additional Information

- 1. Online students will stay on campus and complete their work in the library. Students are expected to report to the library during their assigned online class, and attendance will be taken the same as in other classes.
- 2. Online classes are available to students with scheduling conflicts or academic needs that cannot be met by our regular schedule. Priority will be given to juniors and seniors.
- 3. Online classes are free to students enrolled in six or less classes at WHS, but they cost Wahkiakum School District several hundred dollars. Once students are enrolled in an online class, there is a fee to drop the course as determined by the class provider. **Parents are responsible for paying all fees if students drop or fail online classes**.
